1. Submit incentive sheet by 7/3/24 if applying for spring or spring and fall incentives.
Submit your incentive sheet by 11/15/24 if applying for only fall incentives.
2. Attend two meetings or field days in 2024 to be eligible for incentives in 2024.
3. Discuss with Tina what was completed and what documentation is required.
4. Tina will complete field checks.
5. If needed, the producer may be required to complete additional paperwork prior to payment.
6. Producer will receive a paper invoice in the mail or an electronic version by email showing the incentive invoice amount. A paper check or electronic deposit equal to the amount on the invoice will be issued. The invoice and check may be sent out separately.

I certify that enrolled land is within the Hay River Farmer-Led Watershed Council watershed boundary; and I have not and will not receive any other local, state or federal funds for the same exact practice and /or management methods on the same land for more than three years.
