Mentor a new grazer* – \$250/mentee

It is your responsibility to report completed incentives and provide documentation about activity completion.

1. Submit incentive sheet by 6/27/25 if applying for spring or spring and fall incentives.
Submit your incentive sheet by 12/5/25 if applying for only fall incentives. Payments will be made on a first come, first served basis so turn in your incentive sheet as soon as possible.
2. Attend two meetings or field days in 2025 to be eligible for incentives in 2025. Contact Tina if you would like to be notified about meeting times and aren't already getting notice.
3. Discuss with Tina what was completed and what documentation is required.
4. Tina will complete field checks.
5. If needed, you may be required to complete additional paperwork prior to payment.
6. Producer will receive a paper invoice in the mail or an electronic version by email showing the incentive invoice amount. A paper check or electronic deposit equal to the amount on the invoice will be issued. The invoice and check may be sent out separately.
